

Boston teachers win national awards

BOSTON --Two Boston public schools educators have won prestigious national awards for teaching.

Matthew Dugan, a science teacher at Madison Park Technical High, and Anne Clark, an English teacher at Boston Arts Academy, are winners of the Milken Family Foundation National Educator award.

They are among 80 educators across the country receiving Milken awards this year in recognition of their excellence in the classroom and commitment to students.

Dugan and Clark both get a \$25,000 bonus with the award.

Boston Mayor Tom Menino said they "make school exciting for their students."

Dugan is in his ninth year of teaching science and launched Madison Park's robotics program.

Clark is in her 12th year of teaching English. ■
